

Caption Checklist

Attention getter is two-three words and is strong and interesting.
Attention getter makes the caption/photo connection.
Use strong, visual, specific nouns.
Use colorful, lively action verbs.
First sentence uses the present tense.
First sentence appropriately identifies who is in the photo and describes what is happening without stating the obvious.
Complementary information is presented in past tense and takes the reader beyond the moment of the photo.
Include as many of the who, what, when, where, why and how.
Use active, not passive voice.
Quotes are interesting and not just facts.
All names and grade levels are spelled correctly.
All people are identified appropriately.
Spelling, grammar and punctuation are correct.
